Maybe -G-d forbid-useful for ageing parents. I have seen this.

Often useful in older people: suspicious, paranoid everybody deceives him/her/, jealous [partner is unfaithful]

Delusions of being poisoned, being followed/watched.

May lose feeling of decorum [undressing!]

Fumbles all the time with his hands, picks at face, lips, fingers clothes. This is very easy to recognize if you pay attention to the patient

And sometimes very useful for a dry, spastic cough which is worse when lying down, has to sit up and the cough is worse when talking or drinking.

In children there may be a strong jealousy because they always feel [without reason] that the other children are favoured by the parents.
